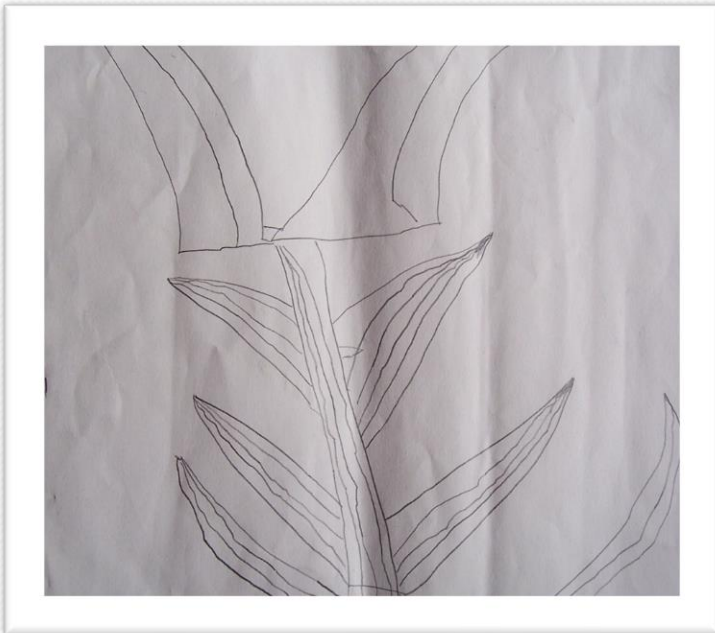


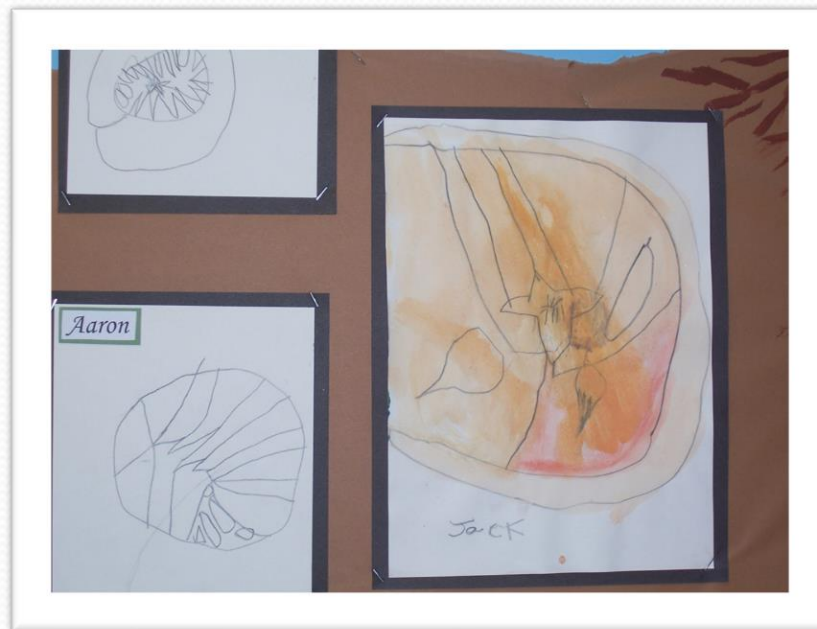
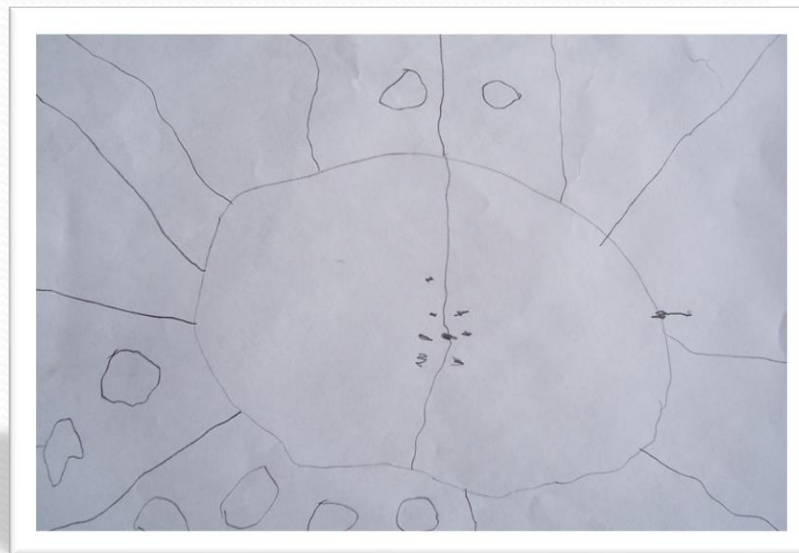
Art plays an important part in the education of every child. It enables children to express their ideas and make discoveries about themselves. They learn to appreciate the creativity of others.

Our pupils learn to value the creative process and not just the outcome. They are encouraged to experiment with and explore different media, techniques and approaches whilst learning about different artists from around the world.

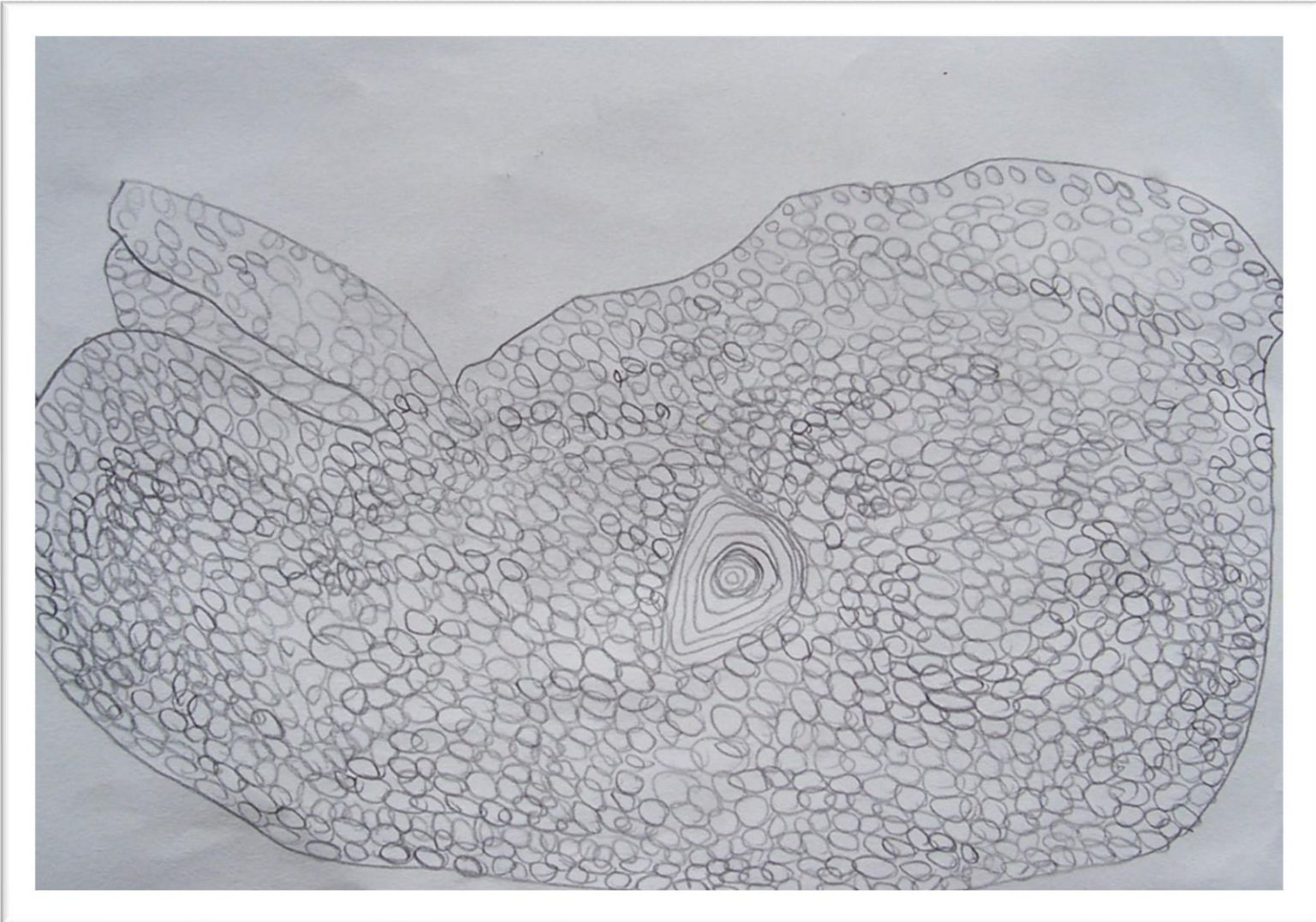
Each child will learn to use different art techniques and develop an awareness of shape, colour, texture and pattern as well as understand the properties of materials.

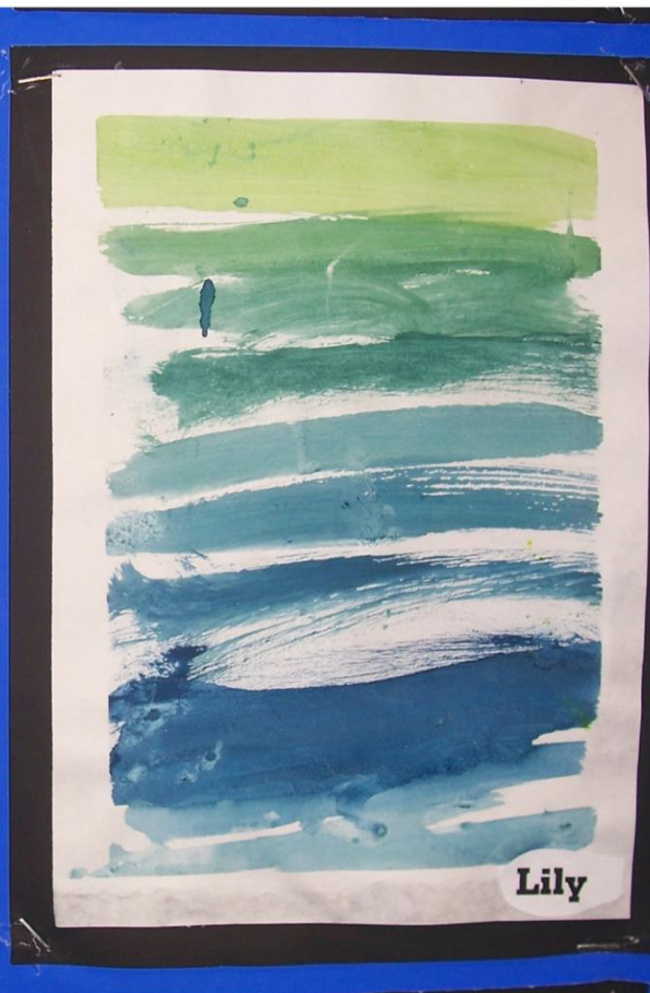

We discussed depth, shade, shiny, translucent, pattern and line.

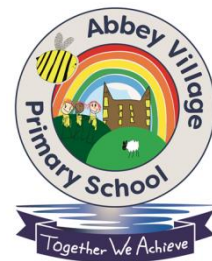




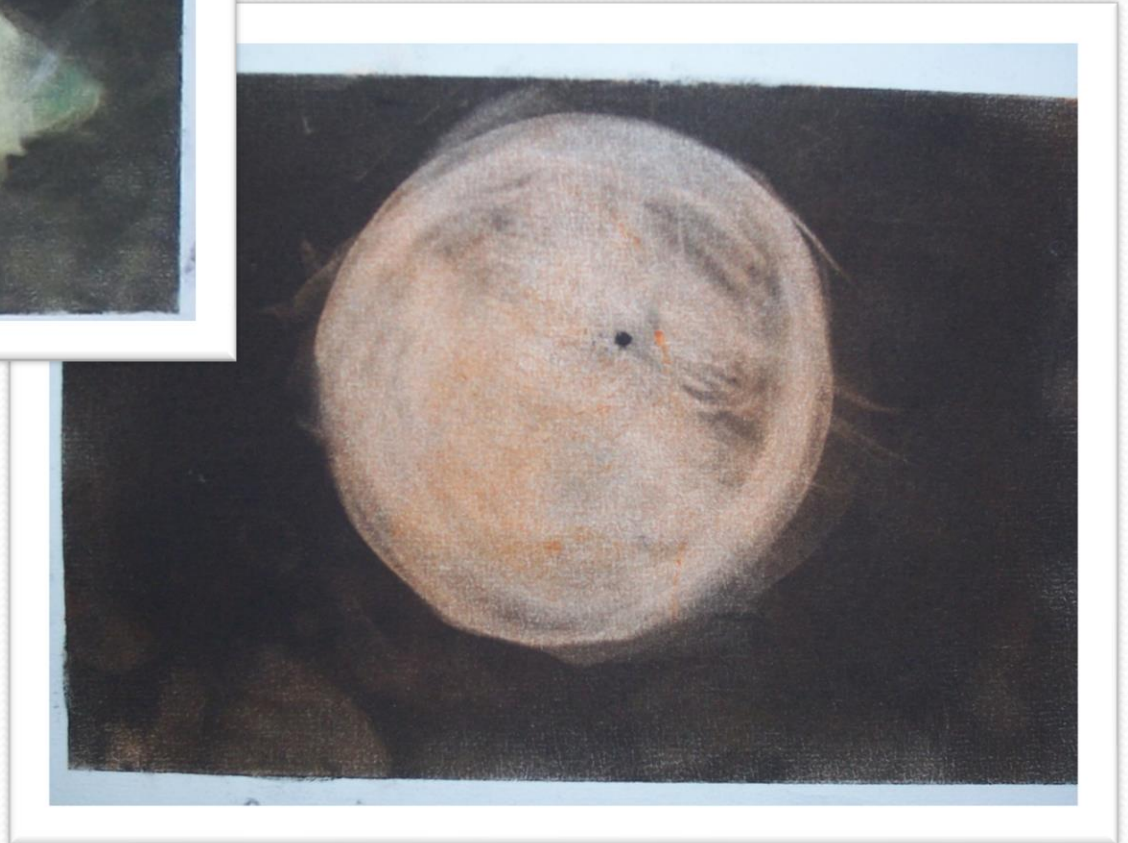
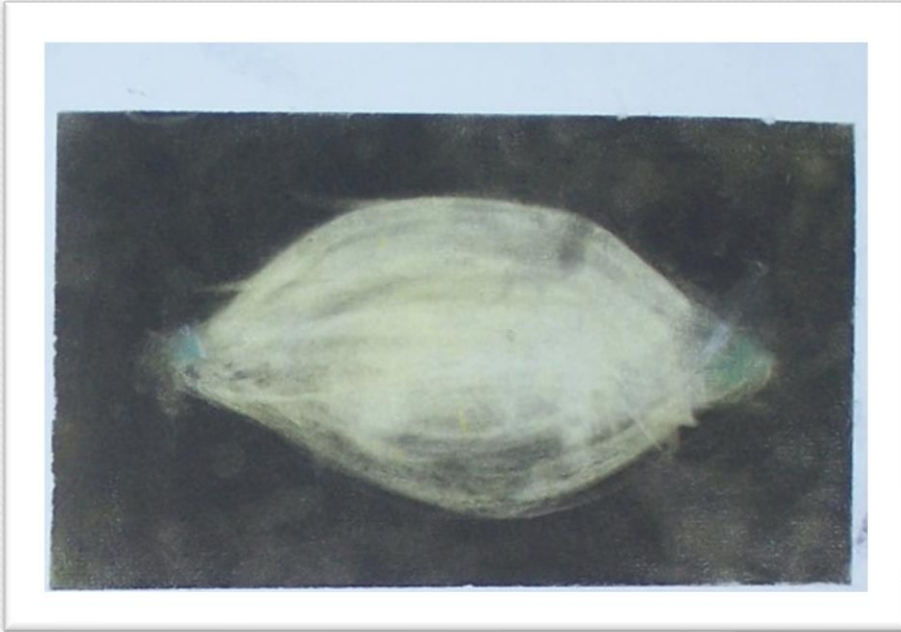
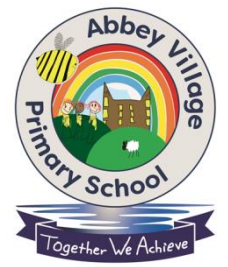

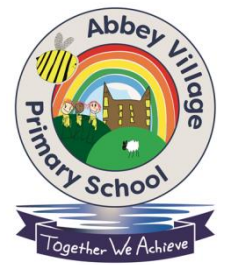


We looked at some mackerel
